- v Manage education opportunities.
- v Be available for FSDO support.
- v Emphasis will be basic pilot skills.
- v Education will consist of three levels.
 - 1. 1. Basic—focusing on private pilot level
 - 2. 2. Advanced—intended for instrument and commercial.
 - 3. Master—intended for CFI and ATP.
