Date: 4-13-13 Meeting Minutes

John Price gave an update on the club plane project and called for an interest meeting after the CMLF meeting.

Coley, Dee, and John Mudgett will be in charge of runway maintenance.

Linwood appointed Bill Lehr to get information about the upcoming fly-in on the internet. Doug will ask his wife about creating a flyer for advertising the fly-in. Dr. Bob moved Dee purchase ten folding picnic tables for \$1300, John Mudgett seconded it, and the club voted to do so.
