Formation flying was discussed and some of the terms that would be used in a preflight briefing would be to

to talk about the nature of the flight, the number of planes flying, joining up and recovery, speeds altitude and hand signals in case of radio failure. Cruise formation and close formation was discussed

Altitudes for the traffic pattern was discussed. 800 ft AGL The pattern altitude for Harrell Field is 800ft agl or 1200ft msl

Altimeter should be set at the field elevation and not at '0' Use 121.0 to get the barometric pressure in the air A gagle departure was discussed

If the temperature is 10C or 50F with visable moisture cloudy with visability 1mi or less icing is very probable When the ISO bars get close together it gets windy The markers on the runway are 98 feet apart in width Use your radio at all times

On base look both ways, square up and look at the departure and the approach ends of the runway Fly Safely

Doc said that the birds were building nests and moved To adjourn
