The Club Rules for traffic pattern altitude are 800 ft. AGL for experimental and GA aircraft.
600 ft AGL for ultra light aircraft.

Departures on runway 36 and the question was asked at what altitude has to be achieved to insure a safe return to the field. It is important to keep the nose down.

There are approximately 40 members and every one should use their radios.

The take off point for runway 36 is at the edge of Talmadge's hanger.

The cones are in place. There are barrels at the end of the end of the runway. Do not land at the very end of the runway and Dee gave examples of why.

For the fly-in: Be alert, the FAA will be present, use standard altitudes, standard patterns, be aware and if there are questions ask the Air Boss.
